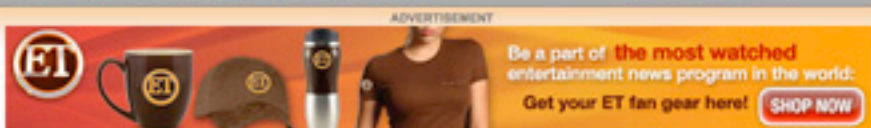

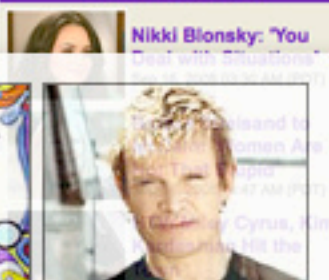

This year the stars received invitations created by YESDESIGNGROUP. YDG came up with the idea of producing a recyclable and reusable garment bag as the invite to the 12th annual ET party sponsored for the fifth year by *People*.

"This year we wanted to create an invite that was not only eco-friendly, but something that the invitees could use long after the event. Our continued collaboration with [ET] raises the bar for invite expectations," says **Lori J. Posner**, owner of YDG.

Once that decision was made, YDG turned to **Jane Wyler** of REUSENIKS, who is known for creating the Clothesnik, a reusable 100 percent cotton garment bag that replaces plastic dry-cleaning bags.

Jane created a special 42-inch garment bag of recycled cotton which was silkscreened so that the party invitation is directly on the bag, pictured above.

"Once again, ET is ahead of the curve with this one-of-a-kind invitation! It's even more special because it is eco-friendly and can be re-used," says **Linda Bell Blue**, Executive Producer of ET.
